Congratulations to all who entered the 2024 Photo competition. The standard of the majority of entries was much improved on last year. The number of entries was considerably more than last year. Well done to all who competed!

We would like to encourage you to keep entering competitions, print your photos, make photobooks and above all, keep clicking.

We have noted a few hints that may help you...

1. When entering a competition, be sure you have entered your image in the correct category.
2. If you take photos on your mobile phone, please make sure you use the Edit tools to enhance your photo. e.g. crop, level, exposure, saturation, these tools are on your phones and adjustment is very important if you enter competitions.
3. Be aware that photos of children with little clothing (or none at all) are not permitted in competitions.
4. Horizons must be straight.
5. An image should have a point of interest and if possible leading lines.
6. The rule of thirds is important in most photographs, however, it is not a necessity.
7. When taking images of people and children (and for that matter animals), make sure they look great – no hair in face, no food on face or clothes, dressed to fit the image. This is not always possible, of course, but for competitions it is quite important.
8. When taking an image for a competition, think about composition, where you stand to take the photograph, where the light is falling, shadows, etc.

Hope this helps all the budding photographers.
