












No planting this year?

Don't worry — you can always prepare for next season by controlling the weeds
OR plant in a potplant



1. Buy or recycle a pot

2. Place in a great location

Find the perfect place for your pot plant on the verandah before you fill it and it is too heavy to move! It needs some morning sunlight, but be cautious of placing it in a location that receives the intense summer heat. A good medium is best!

3. Fill with potting mix

Fill your pot with a good quality potting mix and incorporate some perlite. Perlite aerates the soil, creating a perfect environment for great establishment and root growth.

4. Fertilise (optional)

If you would like to apply a good quality all-purpose fertiliser, do so. Just make sure to mix it into the soil to avoid concentrated levels which could harm the germinating seedlings.

5. Deep water the pot

6. Sow the everlasting seed

Gently sprinkle seed on the surface, making sure it is even. Only a pinch a pot, or else they will be too thick and topple over. Least is best!

7. Gently water seed in

Gently water in the everlasting seed. You may like to keep an eye on the germinating seedlings, and if they're not evenly spaced, you can move them easily. They are very forgiving!

7. Regular watering

Everlastings do not need very much watering! They are a waterwise plant, and do not appreciate overwatering. However, in a pot situation, they are reliant on you! Make sure

they do not dry out and they have a happy medium. Maybe deep water weekly. By following these steps, your everlastings will flourish. Happy planting, and look forward to a beautiful display of flowers!
